

Community and Vocational Service Committee

This committee deals with the club service in the community and its involvement in vocational projects in the local area. The 'community service' aspect of the committee regularly receives requests from local organisations for financial or practical support. The committee makes recommendations to the Club Council as to where club funds raised for local causes should be spent.

The 'vocational service' aspect of the committee is involved with Rotary initiatives such as 'practice interviews' and competitions to promote and encourage the development of young people.

International and Foundation Committee.

The Rotary Foundation is the Rotary movements main charity which through grants and programs enables us to realise the Rotary humanitarian mission throughout the world, including its number-one goal of eradicating polio. The local committee decides which programmes and projects to be involved in.

The International aspect of this committee oversees the club contribution to various International programmes including the response to overseas disasters and crises. It also manages the relationships with other countries e.g. our links with Bourges and the various international exchanges and scholarships.

Club Service Committee

The role of this committee is to provide administrative resource for the Club and ensure its effective operation within the Constitution and Protocols approved by the Rotary International in Britain and Ireland (RIBI). It is chaired by the Vice President / President Elect.

The Club Service committee comprises members with responsibility for finance, Secretariat, Public Relations, Social Secretariat, Membership and attendance.

Club Council

The Council is the governing body of our Rotary Club. It serves from the 1 July at the start of the Rotary year for twelve months. Its members comprise the president, senior vice and junior vice presidents, the immediate past president, treasurer, secretary as previously elected plus six Club members chosen by the members for the year. The six club members usually include the chairmen of the other committees above.

All the other committees report to Club Council on a monthly basis.
